1	6, 8	Vintage Microphones	"RCA 44BX," "RCA 77D," "Westinghouse 'eight ball'"	Cole
2	7, 23	Magazines	"Magazines on a table" – Ginger reads one	
3	7	Time Clock	Part of exposition – used by Pops	Bob
4	7, 17	Coffee Urn	Filled with coffee – used frequently throughout show – coffee poured back in by Lou	
5	7, 17, 20, 31, 77, 81	Mugs	Personalized coffee mugs hanging on pegs/in mailbox cubbies – Pops, Lou, Clifton, Neal, BJ – 'Personalized' as in individual	
6	7	Pay phone	Used throughout show	Bob
7	7	Coke Machine/Sign	Used to get Coke bottles when 'kicked right' – A hand written "out of order" sign is taped to it	Bob
8	7	Mop & Bucket	Used by Pops to clean floor – need it wet	
9	7	(Christmas Cards)	Strung across mailboxes on wall	Bob
10	7	Radio	Placed on shelf above desk	
11	7	(Coat Rack/Chair/Mirror)	Mentioned as part of anteroom	Bob
12	7, 30	Magazines	Located in anteroom – Ginger reads one – Covering the war – See No. 2	
13	7	Calendar	Hung on the wall in the anteroom	Bob
14	8	Music Stands	For bandstand	Bob
15	8	Baby Grand Piano	"Ebony" – Played throughout show	Bob/Scott
16	8	Clifton's Telephone	Placed on Clifton's desk – rotary dial	
17	8, 25	Clifton's Typewriter	Placed on Clifton's desk – "Who put the gum in my typewriter?"	
18	8	Stacks of Papers	Placed on Clifton's desk	
19	8, 17, 76	(Christmas Tree)	"Small and tacky, decorated with one pathetic string of lights," on top of Coke machine – lights to be plugged in by Pops after fiddling with a bad bulb	Bob
20	8	Mesh Cage	Filled with eyeball scoops/utility light	Bob
21	9, 16, 31	Cigar	Pops "chomps frequently on an unlit cigar" – relit on p. 16 (need lighter) – Put in mouth every time the phone rings	
22	10	Contracts/Letters	Clifton is described "carrying contracts and letters"	
23	10, 33	Clip Purse	Neal is described to keep his money in "a teeny clip purse" – Gives Johnny \$2	
24	10, 23	Pipe	Neal is described "carrying a pipe for the right look" – needs lighter	
25	12, 17, 24, 42, 49	Cokes	Connie is described "drinking 12 Cokes during the show and lining the bottles up under her chair" – 1 comes out of machine on p. 17

26	14, 15, 21, 35, 43	Deliveries	Wally has many deliveries – they pile up – Lou takes a hot dog from a delivery on p. 21. They are deliveries from Picadilly Drug Store/Diner – A variety of bags/boxes/crates	
27	15	Soiled Hanky	Pops pulls it from his pocket to clean his mug	
28	15	Cardboard Coffee Cup	Stan drinks coffee from a cardboard container	
29	15	Piece of Paper	Pops reads from it while using the payphone	
30	15	Pencil/Pen	Used to write on the wall next to the payphone – Bulletin board dressings	
31	15	Cable	Stan carries it – black electric cable – twist cock or Edison	
32	15	Sheet Music	Stan enters from hallway with sheet music	
33	15	Papers	Clifton re-enters from his office with a stack of them	
34	15	Copy of “Show Girl”	Pops’ secret magazine – stored in his desk	
35	16, 34	New Arrangement	Zoot sketches one out on the piano top – is it a score or a room layout? – Handed to Neal	
36	16	Sugar/Cream	Sugar located next to coffee urn – cream is fetched from the stoop by Pops	
37	16	Notepad/Pen	Wally’s – writes down what Stan orders him	
38	16	Stepladder	Stan brings it on – used to hang lighting equipment	
39	16	Half a Sandwich	Stan enters with it in his mouth with light/cable	
40	17	Cantone’s Drink	Cantone enters from hallway with it – what kind of drink? In can/glass?	
41	17	Playing Cards	1 deck? 2 decks? Placed where?	
42	17	Hostess Cupcake	Opened by Lou along with Coke	
43	18	Lou’s Notebook	Lou makes note of winning cards	
44	18	Intercom Mic	Used by Pops – “doesn’t work”	Cole
45	19, 38	Headset	Lou’s – worn by Stan – Is there a second?	Emily
46	19	Stan’s Wallet/Money	Stan gives a discard coin to Wally	
47	19	Sheaf of Papers	Clifton explodes out of office with papers in hand	
48	21, 43, 45	Hot Dogs	Lou takes a hot dog from one of Wally’s deliveries – Wally gives Connie a partially unwrapped hot dog – Wally takes a big bite and puts it in his pocket	
49	22, 23	Mail?	Ginger checks her mail – is there anything there? Neal also checks his mail (finds banana peel)	
50	22	Snowball	Hits Neal in the face – cleaned up by Pops	
51	23	“Enormous Crash”	Is this a crash box or sound effect?	Cole
52	23	Banana Peel	Pulled from Neal’s mailbox	
53	25, 76	Ann’s Mail	Fan mail – Given to her by Pops – “nobody ever got this much mail” – is it a routine thing?	
54	27, 52, 73	Scripts	Clifton enters from his office – one for everyone - loose-leaf	
55	27, 60, 70	Sheet of Music	BJ looks at it – is it part of the script packet or #34?

75	72	Sombrero	Johnny enters wearing a sombrero	Emily
76	78	Tab Board	Connie tap dances on a tap board – 4'X3'	Cole
77	78	Mirror Ball	Tacky – lowered by Stan on rope	Bob, RJ
78	80	Paper Cups	The band is told not to leave paper cups around	
79	80	Ashtray	The band is told to use an ashtray – is there one for Pops?	
80	81	Newspaper	Pops folds the newspaper he's been reading	
81	81	Pay Envelopes	Clifton enters with pay envelopes – are they opened on stage?	
82	81, 83	Clifton's Wallet	Gives Wally a dollar bill – Gives Pops a dollar bill
